HILL SUES FOR ACCESS TO PUBLIC'S RECORDS

(Cheyenne, WY)

Superintendent of Public Instruction Cindy Hill today asked the court to assist her in her efforts to collect public records. Over four months ago, Superintendent Hill requested certain documents from the Governor's office and the Wyoming Department of Education (WDE). As of today, the Superintendent has received only a small fraction of the documents possessed by the Governor's office and the WDE.

Hill said "These documents I am requesting are essential to provide Wyoming people a complete and accurate picture of what their government is doing. I expect the documents to shed light on what was the driving force behind Senate File 104 and the political attacks I have endured over the past months." SF 104 removed general supervision and all but a handful of the duties of the superintendent. The constitutionality of that act is currently being challenged in the Wyoming Supreme Court.

Hill concluded "After waiting for many months I am left with very little recourse. I cannot continue to wait indefinitely for the documents to be provided at some point in the distant future. I am optimistic that the court will assist me in gathering this important information and I look forward to sharing with the public these documents created by public servants using public funds. It is time for the Governor to produce these records. They belong to the public. What is he afraid that the citizens of the State of Wyoming will learn?"
